

60 Second HWS JustFACTS Surveys

The 60 Second JustFACTS Surveys are anonymous surveys designed by the JustFACTS team that ask 5-6 short questions on a topic of interest to the HWS community. Survey invitations are delivered by electronic mail to every student on campus or a specified subpopulation. Data collection lasts for approximately 5 days. The web based survey is designed to work on smart phones or on a computer with a web browser.

Selected Results

- 1. A large majority (86%) of HWS students supports the current smoking control policy prohibiting smoking in campus student residences and all other indoor common space areas used or visited by more than one person or supports a more restrictive policy.
- 2. 52% of HWS students support a more restrictive policy that would include a) prohibiting smoking within 50 feet of the entrance to any campus building, b) a complete prohibition of smoking everywhere except in a limited number of small sheltered designated areas, or c) a complete campus ban on smoking both inside and outside of buildings.
- 3. Students supporting the current smoking control policy or a more restrictive policy are divided on whether such smoking control policies should extend to e-cigarettes: 48% support control policies being applied to e-cigarettes, while 52% do not.
- 4. A large majority of HWS students do not smoke pipes, cigars, cigarettes, or e-cigarettes. See the chart below.
