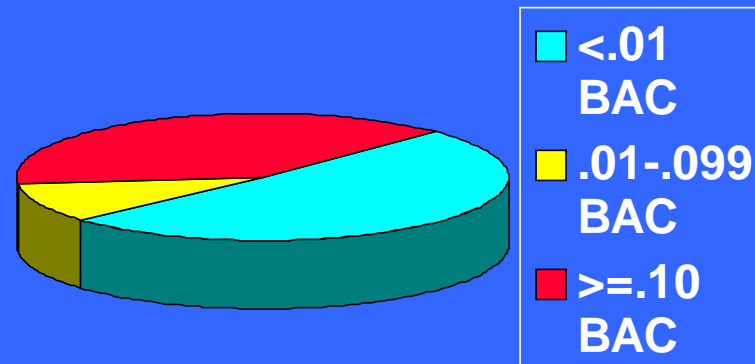


Alcohol and Traffic Fatalities

- Traffic Crashes are leading cause of death for <40 yo
- 22,413 were killed in alcohol related crashes (49% of fatalities) in 1989
- 1989 Years of Potential Life Lost
 - men 470,000
 - women 139,960
- Modeling Predicts 47% reduction in traffic fatalities with elimination of alcohol from roadways
